SHWAB: The president shared a report from Ken, who attended the last meeting on March 17th:

- South Central Waterfront Combining District is still delayed
- April Gerusa let SCWAB Chair and Vice Chair know that there is no timetable for adoption of the Regulation Plan
- Developers have been wiggling out of Affordable Housing PUD requirements
 - 200 E Riverside PUD is not consistent with SCW Vision Framework, nor city quidelines
 - https://services.austintexas.gov/edims/document.cfm?id=447509
- PUDS override SCWAB without the approved Regulating Plan
 - Currently Density Bonuses across the city are being recalibrated by the Austin Planning Department
 - This is a hold up for the approval of SCWAB Regulating Plan
- Austin Board's are being consolidated
 - SCWAB listed as a potential candidate for Board consolidation
 - SCWAB to potentially be rolled into the Downtown Commission
 - no work yet whether current SCWAB member organizations will remain the same
